Application requirements for the Good Works Scholarship are:

- Application form
- Unofficial Transcript
- 2 Recommendation letters (*1 from teacher/counselor or administrator and 1 from someone of your choosing*)
- Essay- "Describe how you have demonstrated leadership abilities both in and out of school"
 - Essays must be in MLA Format -1,000 words max (*12 pt. font, double spaced, Times New Roman*)
- Acceptance letters to school(s) you plan to attend
- Resume
- Personal Statement/ Brief Bio (*500 words max*)
