Minimum ACT composite score of 21 or above and 3.0 GPA. We will consider applicants until all available positions have been filled for this scholarship.

Applicants will be contacted by the sponsor depending on which campus is marked as the one to be attended. Students are invited to schedule interviews. Interviews are held on the Bay Minette, Brewton, Monroeville and Thomasville campuses and Ambassadors are chosen for the Bay Minette, Brewton, Monroeville, Thomasville, and Gilbertown campuses depending on the number of slots available from previous ambassadors who have left or graduated. Minimum grade point average of 2.5 with a 16 ACT composite score.

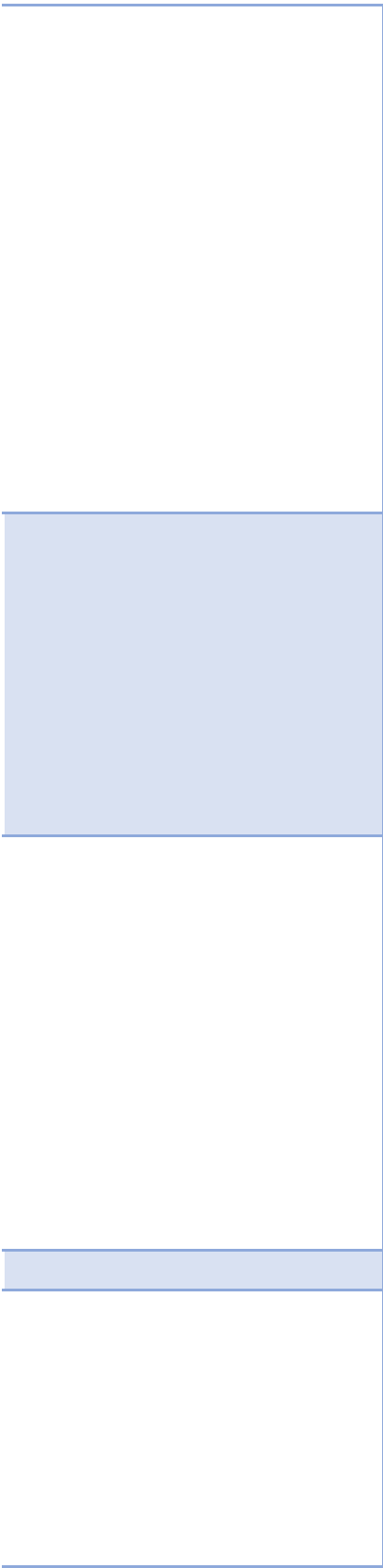
